Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Between

Vidya Vihar Institute of Technology (VVIT), Purnea

And

NOBA GSR, Patna

PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 20th day of April, 2020 by and between Vidya Vihar Institute of Technology (VVIT), Purnea, Bihar, hereinafter referred to as "VVIT," and NOBA GSR (Netarhat Old Boys Association - Global Social Responsibility), hereinafter referred to as "NOBA GSR."

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for collaboration between VVIT and NOBA GSR in the areas of Research and Development (R&D) for the maintenance and development of sanitary pad dispensers and incinerators, and in Social Activities through the NSS Wing of VVIT and NOBA GSR.

OBJECTIVES OF COLLABORATION

- * To promote R&D initiatives for the development and efficient maintenance of sanitary pad dispensers and incinerators.
- * To conduct joint social outreach programs addressing community needs, especially in the areas of health, hygiene, and education.
- * To foster the spirit of innovation, community service, and social responsibility among students and volunteers of both organizations.
- * To leverage the technical expertise of VVIT and the community engagement expertise of NOBA GSR for mutual benefit and societal impact.

SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

1. R&D FOR SANITARY PAD DISPENSERS AND INCINERATORS

DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT:

VVIT will provide technical expertise, resources, and infrastructure for the design, prototyping, and development of sanitary pad dispensers and incinerators.

NOBA GSR will support with community feedback, end-user requirements, and field-level testing.

MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADATION:

VVIT will collaborate with NOBA GSR to maintain existing sanitary pad dispensers and incinerators deployed in the community.

Both parties will explore and implement innovative solutions to enhance the efficiency and sustainability of these systems.

FUNDING AND RESOURCE SHARING:

NOBA GSR will support the initiative by sourcing funds, sponsorships, or grants.

VVIT will provide technical and intellectual resources for R&D activities.

2. SOCIAL ACTIVITIES COLLABORATION

JOINT INITIATIVES:

The NSS Wing of VVIT and NOBA GSR will jointly conduct health camps, awareness drives, and workshops on menstrual hygiene management, waste disposal, and other social issues.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT:

NSS volunteers from VVIT will actively participate in NOBA GSR's social outreach programs.

NOBA GSR will offer mentorship and field training opportunities for NSS volunteers.

Community Impact:

Programs such as cleanliness drives, tree plantations, skill development workshops, and educational campaigns will be organized collaboratively.

Impact assessments will be conducted periodically to evaluate the outcomes of these initiatives.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

VVIT

Provide expertise, faculty, and infrastructure for R&D activities.

Engage students from engineering and NSS wings for field projects and community programs.

Assist in the documentation and dissemination of research findings and social outreach outcomes.

NOBA GSR

Provide field-level support and funding for R&D projects.

Facilitate community engagement and ensure participation in social activities.

Collaborate on the deployment and monitoring of sanitary pad dispensers and incinerators.

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

Any intellectual property generated through joint R&D activities will be co-owned by VVIT and NOBA GSR.

Prior written agreement will govern the commercialization or licensing of such intellectual property.

Duration and Termination

This MoU will be effective from the date of signing and remain in force for a period of three (3) years, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement.

Either party may terminate the MoU with a 30-day written notice, provided ongoing activities are concluded responsibly.

Monitoring and Review

A Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) comprising members from VVIT and NOBA GSR will be formed to oversee the progress of collaborative activities.

Biannual reviews will be conducted to assess achievements and plan future initiatives.

Amendments

Any amendments to this MoU will be made in writing with mutual consent from both parties.
