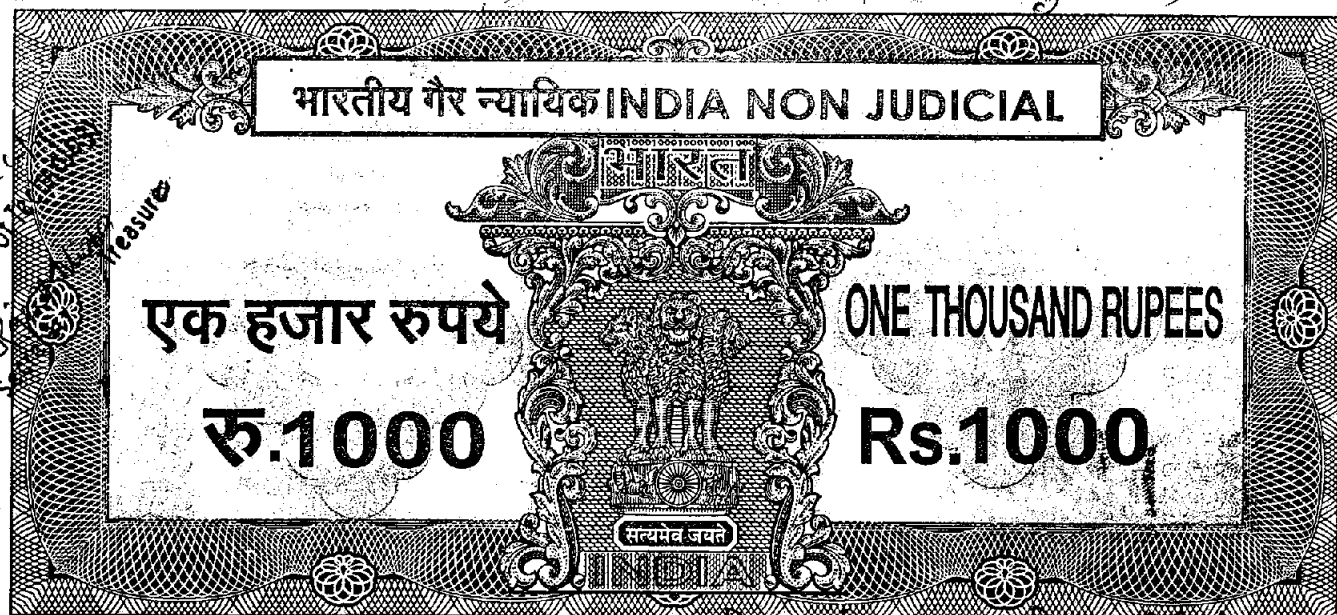

**NOW THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The name of the trust shall be **VIDYA VIHAR EDUCATIONAL TRUST**. The deed shall be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 2006.
2. The office of the Trust shall be situated in the building of M/S Brajesh Automobiles Pvt. Ltd., NH31, Purnea, and the address may be changed as and when found necessary by the Trustees.
3. The **OBJECTS OF THE TRUST** shall be any or all of the following:
  - a) To propagate education and learning including establishment, maintenance and support of schools and other educational institutions.
  - b) To make provision to advance the cause of, and impart Nursery, Primary, Secondary, Higher, Commercial, Industrial, Technical, Physical and all or any other type or kind of education.
  - c) To establish, maintain, take over management, administer or run any institutions, colleges engaged in the imparting of education and training up to any level for any discipline including engineering, medical, business management, accountancy, information technology that may be found necessary and/or desirable.
  - d) To impart education to children and for the purpose to do all acts that may be necessary.
  - e) To establish, run, manage and administer any institution or college or school to train persons to be teachers who will impart education to children and / or students in Schools, Colleges and any other similar institutions.
  - f) To promote adult education.
  - g) To hold, arrange, and organize meetings, lectures, talks, discussions, seminars, symposia, conferences, competitions, research and study visits, tours, excursions, exhibitions, debates, cinema, audio-visual programmes, the artistic performances and other cultural activities, sports and games.
  - h) To establish, maintain and support libraries, museums and reading rooms and distribution of books etc., for advancement of education and knowledge in general.
  - i) To provide and meet all expenses of the School and other educational institutions.

- d) In the event of vacancy of the post of the Managing Trustee -cum -President, Smt. Vijay Lakshmi Mishra shall take over as Managing Trustee -cum -President.
- d) In the event of retirement /death of any office bearer, remaining trustees shall appoint any other person as office bearer in his place who may be helpful in achieving the object of the Trust.
- e) The maximum number of Trustees shall not exceed eleven.
- f) A Trustee shall cease to hold his Office as Trustee of the Trust if he becomes insane or lunatic.

**5. MANAGEMENT**

- a) The Management, control of the property and affairs of the Trust aforesaid shall be vested in the Trustees with full powers and authority to purchase or hold, land or

hereditament and construct any buildings for the object of the Trust or any funds or any other properties or investment at any time, subject to the Trust of these presents. It shall be lawful for the Trustees from time to time to frame such rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust and charities as they deem fit and to alter or vary the same from time to time to make new rules and regulations provided such rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with the terms and intents of these presents and not inconsistent with the provisions of Section 2(15), 11 to 13 and 80-G of the Income-Tax Act, 1961.

- b) The Trustees shall meet as often as possible but not less than three times in a year for efficient management of the Trust, to consider the income and expenditure and for disposing of all such other matters as may arise in such meetings.
- c) At the meetings of the Trustees, six members will form the quorum.
- d) At all the meetings of Trustees, Managing Trustee cum President or in his absence the First Vice President or in their absence the Second Vice President or in their absence any other Trustee shall be the Chairman and all decisions of the Trustees shall be by majority vote. In case of equality of votes, only Managing Trustee -cum -President shall have a casting vote.
- e) All proceedings of the meetings of the Trustees shall be recorded in a Minutes Book kept for the purpose.
- f) In case of any difference of opinion between the Trustees in any matter connected with the Trust and its administration the decision of the majority will be final and binding on all the Trustees.
- g) That the trustees shall constitute a Governing Council for each of the colleges/institutions run by the trust in accordance with the rules framed by the Trust and applicable at that time. The function of such Governing Council shall only be of advisory nature on matters relating to organization, management and administration of colleges / institutions and shall have no power in policy matter.
- h) That the trustees can constitute a Project Management Committee under the chairmanship of a senior competent expert for establishment of any college/institution. Trustees may appoint a Chief Project Manager & Salary for liaisoning with all Government, Semi-Government and Statutory bodies. The financial powers will be vested with the Managing Trust -cum -President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Trust who will be the <sup>ex-officio</sup> members of the Project Management Committee

- i) That the Board of Trustees are also authorized to constitute such other advisory bodies as they deem fit for the smooth and efficient running of colleges/institutions run by the Trust.
- j) That the trustees shall constitute as many sub-committees as may be necessary or expedient from time to time for the management of the various institutions of the trust.
- k) The office of the Governing Council, Project Management Committee and its other advisory bodies, committees and sub-committees shall be same as that of the Trust.
- l) The trust may dissolve and reconstitute the Governing Council, Project Management Committee and its other advisory bodies, committees and sub-committees as and when they feel necessary in the best interest of colleges/institutions run by the Trust.

6. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES

- a) To manage Trust Funds and collect and recover interest, income and profits thereof and to pay thereout the expenses of collection and other outgoing, if any.
- b) The Trustees shall have all the powers specifically conferred to do things as may be required for the proper conduct of the Trust and in the interest of the Trust, whenever such powers are not specifically conferred.
- c) The Trustees shall be entitled from time to time to open, maintain and operate a bank account or accounts in the name of the Trust or in the name of the Institutions at such Bank or Banks as they may from time to time decide and may at any time pay or cause to be paid any monies forming part of the Trust Fund/Institution Fund or income thereof to the credit of any such account or account either by way of fixed current account or any other account. Any such account shall be opened by the Managing Trustee -cum -President, Secretary and Treasurer but can be operated jointly by any two of them.
- d) The Trustees shall have powers to maintain and defend all such suits and take such other steps as may be reasonable and requisite for the preservation of the Trust property and the protection of the title thereof. At the discretion of the Trustees, Managing Trustee -cum -President, Secretary and Treasurer or such other authorized person or persons shall represent them in all such proceedings.
- e) The Trustees may at any time receive voluntary contributions from any person or persons by donations, legacy, gift, annual or monthly subscription, for the benefit of

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the Trust. The Trustees shall apply such contributions in accordance with the objects of the Trust.

- f) Proper accounts showing all receipts and disbursements made on account of the Trust hereby constituted shall be kept by the Treasurer who shall prepare Receipts and Payment Account, Income and Expenditure Account and Balance sheet as on March 31, every year and shall be duly audited by qualified chartered accountant.
  - g) The Secretary and Treasurer may from time to time, appoint any accountant, clerk and other officials and employees as they may deem expedient, and fix and pay their remuneration out of the Trust fund or the income thereof.
  - h) The Trustees shall have power to raise or borrow or take loans from the Bank or Financial Organizations or from any person including firm, body corporate, Trust etc. for the purposes of Trust from time to time in the name of the Trust or otherwise on behalf of the Trust sums of money as they may from time to time deem expedient either on the mortgage of the whole or any part of the property of the Trust or by bonds, debentures, deposit, receipts, promissory notes with or without security or in such other manner as they may consider proper. The loan document shall be jointly executed by Managing Trustee -cum -President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Trust .
  - i) That the office bearer may take appropriate salary or any remuneration as decided by the trust for the work done for the trust or any institution run by the trust.
  - j) All the funds of the Trust shall be dealt with under Section 13 of the Income Tax Act of 1961.
  - k) That the trustees shall have power to amend, alter or rescind the rules and to interpret their meaning whenever the rules and byelaws framed do not cover any emergency or are ambiguous provided that such change or interpretation does not conflict with the aims and objects of the trust. The trustees shall follow in all their business , the new rules, bye laws, election rules framed separately, confirmed and approved by special General Body Meeting

7. In the event of the dissolution or the winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining on the dissolution shall be transferred to another Trust, Society or institution founded by majority of the trustees of this trust and that in no event shall the assets so remaini be distributed among the Trustees. The decision of the Trust to whom the property shall be given will be taken by the majority vote of the Trustees.
